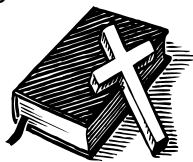

Mission Statement

The primary function of the UCBC Liturgical Dance Ministry is to utilize dance as a praise & worship tool to honor the holiness and supremacy of God. The UCBC Liturgical Dance Ministry is compelled to create and minister dances and choreo-dramas that focus on praise & worship, deliverance, edification, healing, salvation and warfare. The dance ministry's second function is to nurture every dance member's relationship with God through prayer, witnessing, intensive dance training and Bible study. Finally, the function of the dance ministry is to share liturgical dance with our home church congregation, other church congregations, and ultimately shelters, prisons and senior facilities.

Objectives

1. The dance ministry is an integral part of the United Community Baptist Church (UCBC), where the Rev. Colin L. Campbell is pastor. The primary objective of the dance ministry is to support the mission and vision of our pastor and first lady to always be ready to minister when commissioned.
2. The second objective is to maintain an order of ministry that provides a viable structure for the upkeep of the regular rehearsal schedule and the fulfillment of all ministry obligations throughout the year. Such a structure would engage the leadership and membership alike in excellent service unto the Lord.
3. The third objective is to train every active member of the UCBC Liturgical Dance Ministry in the knowledge of dance through warm-up, dance classes and praise & worship; as well as to develop a spiritual support group amongst the membership through intercessory prayer, Bible Study, testimonies, and consecration services.

UCBC Liturgical Dance Ministry Structure

UCBC's Liturgical Dance Ministry currently consist of 21 active members. We are under the leadership of the Advisory Team. As we grow in number, the leadership team will also be supported by Chaplain Mothers, Division Leaders, additional Dance/Rehearsal Captains, Administrative and Financial Support, and Coordinators.

The leadership team will conduct periodic new member orientation workshops for prospective new members, ages 7 and up (who are active members of UCBC). Special rehearsals for ministerial engagements may be scheduled for children under 7 (who are active UCBC members) at a later date.

Accomplishments
